National Tree Day Planting: A Great Community Event



On Sunday 31st July, at Rosser Park in Mount Tamborine, forty people took part in a planting blitz hosted by TM Landcare. Parents, children and older folk enjoyed the very friendly, feel-good morning, planting and watering in 300 trees and shrubs. These will increase the biodiversity of the local natives – plants, insects and animals – that call the park home.

This annual activity is part of Tamborine Mountain Landcare's mission to restore the mountain's remnant stands of rainforest in reserves and parks.

Our New Regeneration Project: Kinabalu Drive



Opposite the bottom end of our Areca Gully site is a large area of Queensland Government land, overrun with invasive weeds. TM Landcare has recently signed a Deed of Agreement with the Queensland Department of Resources, which allows our organisation to carry out weed control and appropriate tree planting over a three-year period, in order to restore the native ecology. Most of the work will be performed by contractors, with our Tuesday Team volunteers undertaking some planting.

This is an exciting new project for TM Landcare. As our funds and capabilities allow, we are always looking for new areas to rehabilitate. Our Piccabeen Bookshop will be the major source of funding for this project, supplemented by funds provided for such purposes by generous donors, particularly Thunderbird Park.

A Tale of Two Vines: The Story of an Iconic Endangered Butterfly



Our three-year Birdwing Butterfly Project at The Shelf is about to be successfully concluded. We have planted 500 vines and thousands of food plants to help this spectacular species survive and thrive.
