In accordance with our Constitution (18.3), "At each annual general meeting of the association, the members of the management committee (including the president, vice-president, treasurer, and secretary) must retire from office, but are eligible, on nomination, for re-election."

- Secretary
- Treasurer
- not more than eight regular Management Committee members

If you have an interest or expertise in the following areas, we'd be particularly pleased if you would nominate:

- events coordination

- education
- media communications
- plant propagation
- knowledge of local flora and fauna habitat management

If you would like to put up your hand for the committee, here's how:

- You need to be a current member
- You need two current TM Landcare members to nominate you
- Your nomination must be in writing, signed by you and those who are nominating you
- The form must be received by the secretary at least 14 days before the AGM on 20th November (i.e. received no later than Friday 4th November.)

Richmond Birdwing Butterfly Project: A Great Success Story

This three-year project at The Shelf is now nearing completion. It began as an Energex offset project, with many trees planted at the site over four years. TM Landcare then added more diversity by planting 2000 nectar trees and 500 Birdwing Butterfly vines, designed to attract the endangered, iconic species and encourage them to lay their eggs on the vines for their emerging caterpillars to munch on. Once an empty cow paddock, the site is now a great demonstration of successful regeneration.

Our thanks go to everyone who has been involved in the project:

- our contractor, Victoria Bakker, and her crew of dedicated bush regenerators from Forest Rehabilitation Ecology
- our local Birdwing Butterfly expert and our mentor, Richard Bull, who has provided scientific input and passionate commitment to the project
- our volunteers who have assisted in the work of planting and weeding

Ongoing funding by Scenic Rim Regional Council and our own Landcare funds will ensure that the site continues to be cared for. Visitors are welcome to check out the site. Access is by foot only.
